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I. INTRODUCTION / WELCOME

I.I. INTRODUCTION

Rally Poland is organized by Polish Automobile and Motorcycle Federation (PZM) in cooperation with Polish Automobile Club. Rally Poland is the second oldest rally in the world and the most prestigious motorsport event in Poland. As many as 78 editions of Rally Poland were held since I92I. Rally Poland's home since 2005 has been Mikołajki in the picturesque Masurian lake district, a three-hour drive north from the capital Warsaw, where high-speed all-gravel stages are commonplace.

This year we have prepared I6 special stages on gravel roads. Most of them are known from previous editions of Rally Poland however, some of them (or their parts) will be new to everyone. Rally fans will also enjoy the best driver's duels at the Mikolajki Arena stage. These spectacular stages will be run two times. The Rally HQ will be placed in a popular tourist resort Hotel Gołębiewski in Mikolajki. Service Park will be located on a mixed hard surface (concrete and hardened gravel) in the vicinity of Hotel Gołębiewski situated in very heart of the Land of Great Lakes, surrounded by wonderful tourist trials.

I.2. <u>HISTORY</u>

The first edition of Polish classic was held in 1921. All competitors tackled the loop from Warsaw through Bialowieza and back to Warsaw. Tadeusz Heyne (Dodge) was the fastest among the six drivers and went down to the history of the event. In the twenties and thirties of the XX century there were twelve editions of the event. Rally Poland was stopped by the II World War and returned in 1947. Since 1960 the history of Rally Poland as a round of the FIA European Rally Championship has begun and such famous names like Rauno Aaltonen. Tony Fall. Timo Makinen. Jean-Claude Andruet. Walter Rohrl. Bernard Darniche. Antonio Zanini or Sobieslaw Zasada can find on the entry and the winners lists. In 1973. right after the launch of the FIA World Rally Championship, the event was once adopted for the series and won by Achim Warmbold co-driven by Jean Todt. Rally Poland was organized on tarmac stages in various parts of the country: in Cracow. Wroclaw and Klodzko. Since 2005 the headquarters of the event is located in Mikolajki. north-east part of Poland. Spectacular gravel roads winding along Mazurian forests and lakes substituted the tarmac stages.

In 2014, for the first time in history, Rally Poland was organized not only in Poland. Four special stages were scheduled to take place in neighbouring Lithuania. Sébastien Ogier and Julien Ingrassia racked up their fifth victory of the season when they won 7Ist Rally Poland on its return to the series for the first time since 2009. The French duo has diced for honours throughout the event with Polo R WRC teammates Andreas Mikkelsen and Ola Floene. Behind Mikkelsen, Thierry Neuville and Nicolas Gilsoul picked up the final podium position, their second of the season with the Hyundai i2O WRC.

In 2015 Sébastien Ogier and Julien Ingrassia claimed their triumph in 72nd Rally Poland holding off Polo R WRC team-mates Andreas Mikkelsen and Ola Floene after a thrilling battle to the finish of the rally. A stunning performance from the Ford Fiesta RS WRC crew of Ott Tanak and Raigo Molder rewarded them with their first podium of the season. Tanak has driven the rally of his life, winning a number of stages as well as leading on Friday. Going into the final Power Stage he and Latvala were neck and neck but second fastest time, coupled with an off for Latvala, secured the Estonian the second podium position of his WRC career and Molder's first-ever WRC podium. While Latvala managed to reach the end of the stage, a damaged radiator halted his progress on the road section back to service and ultimately the Finn incurred penalties for lateness, dropping him to fifth. Hayden Paddon therefore climbed to an unexpected fourth in the lead Hyundai i20 WRC and team-mate Thierry Neuville finished sixth









behind Latvala. The Belgian was also lucky to reach the finish, having rolled in the first stage. Kris Meeke climbed to seventh, benefitting when Robert Kubica was slowed with a diff and handbrake problem in the opening stage and then a puncture in the Power Stage.

In 2016 Andreas Mikkelsen snatched victory in one of the most dramatic finishes to a round of the FIA World Rally Championship, when he and fellow Norwegian Anders Jaeger won PZM 73rd Rally Poland on Sunday. The Volkswagen Polo R WRC driver confirmed his second ever WRC win and a first for codriver Jaeger with the fifth quickest time on the final Power Stage. But the damage had been done on the previous special when long-time leader Ott Tänak of the DMACK World Rally Team sustained a puncture. lost over 40 seconds and slipped to second overall. The flat tyre deprived the heartbroken Estonian of a maiden WRC win and Ford and M-Sport of taking their first victory on a round of the championship since the 2012 Wales Rally GB. Hyundai's Hayden Paddon stayed out of trouble over Sunday's four treacherous stages to seal the final place on the podium for the Korean manufacturer. Belgian Thierry Neuville was a mere 0.8 seconds behind in fourth in a second i20 WRC. Jari-Mati Latvala held off a fierce charge from World Champion and team-mate Sébastien Ogier to confirm fourth place, although the treacherous final morning's road conditions surprised even Ogier who missed out on a podium finish for the first time this year.

WRC 2 category developed into a three-horse race over the closing four stages between the Finnish duo of Esapekka Lappi and Teemu Suninen and Welshman Elfyn Evans. The latter managed to slither into second with the quickest time on the muddy opening stage, but Lappi maintained his composure until a flat tyre destroyed his dream of taking a second successive Polish WRC 2 win in SS2O and gifted the victory to Suninen. Evans also took advantage of Lappi's misfortune to move back into second.

In 2017 Thierry Neuville and Nicolas Gilsoul racked up their victory in Poland after a neck and neck fight which ultimately forced Ott Tänak into an unlucky mistake as he pushed to the maximum for the win. The Estonian powered into the lead in a final day opener but then hit a tree in the following stage. While he was able to complete the stage, he was then forced out with too much damage; the second consecutive year he has been so close to claiming the winner's trophy in Poland. As such, Hayden Paddon and Sebastian Marshall moved up to second to give Hyundai a one-two, with Sébastien Ogier and Julien Ingrassia claiming the final podium position for M-Sport. Ogier was hanging back for a push and maximum points in the Power Stage but he ended up in a field in the penultimate stage when the car snapped out at the rear. Four points in the Power Stage were a welcome addition to his tally however. Behind the leading trio, Dani Sordo had a near miss with a tree final day morning and then a puncture this afternoon, but fourth for the Spaniard alongside Hyundai's one-two was a great result for the team. Stéphane Lefebvre had a tricky morning, off the road in the first stage and then he clipped a fence in the second, distracted by a tool kit that worked loose and ended up under the brake pedal. Nevertheless he managed to move into fifth in the Power Stage, benefitting when Teemu Suninen had a near off. While a fine result for the Finn in his first outing in a 2017 World Rally Car, he was disappointed to have made a mistake in the final stage of the rally. Mads Rstberg claimed seventh and Elfyn Evans eighth.Ole Christian Veiby won the FIA WRC 2 Championship, the Norwegian claiming his first victory in the category after leading for all but the first stage. He beat Pontus Tidemand by 32.9 seconds and moves into second in the Championship. Nil Solans took his third consecutive victory in the FIA Junior WRC Championship.

In 2018 Rally Poland returned back to European Rally Championship and Nikolay Gryazin has secured his victory on PZM Rally Poland, surviving a late charge from Hyundai development driver Jari Huttunen. Running on worn tyres, ERC Junior Under 28 star Gryazin lost time throughout a final day afternoon but still managed to beat Huttunen, who threw caution to the win on the rally's final stage, Baranowo. Huttunen brought his battle-scarred Hyundai i20 home with a rear puncture, broken bumper and spoiler







in a last-ditch attempt to overhaul Gryazin for overall victory. Despite winning Baranowo by 4.6s, it was not enough for Huttunen, Gryazin hanging on for victory by only 8.3s. Huttunen had incurred a IO second penalty for checking in one minute late to SSI4, which transpired to be pivotal in settling the lead battle. Toksport WRT's Chris Ingram completes the overall podium and secured second in ERC Junior U28, holding off ŠKODA AUTO Deutschland driver Fabian Kreim. Fellow ŠKODA driver Miko Marczyk finished fifth, ensuring four of the top five positions were occupied by young stars in R5 cars.

In 2019 Alexey Lukyanuk after taking his first win on PZM 76th Rally Poland and scoring maximum points, was back in the hunt for his second FIA European Rally Championship title. Taking the lead from Hyundai Motorsport N's ERC3 Junior graduate Jari Huttunen first thing on Saturday morning after stage two. Lukyanuk didn't look back, winning by 59.8 s. After a broken damper and puncture on Saturday only caused a minor delay, another puncture occurred when Lukyanuk hit a rock on the morning pass of Gmina Mragowo. His lead was reduced but he still remained out front and from there he was untouchable, winning the remaining stages to cement his first win of 2019 and his ninth in the ERC. Huttunen's return to the European championship was equally as successful as his appearance on this event last year, repeating his second place finish with a factory-supported Hyundai i20 R5. Championship leader Łukasz Habaj added another podium to his impressive 2019 trophy cabinet, limiting his points loss to Lukyanuk to ensure he would leave his home country still top of the ERC standings.

In 2020 Polish Automobile and Motorcycle Federation (PZM) has decided to postpone 77th Rally Poland to the 2021 season. The decision was the result of a pandemic situation caused by coronavirus in Poland and Europe. The situation related to COVID-19, including restrictions on cross-border traffic and the unpredictable deadline for their total removal did not allow the time to implement the arrangements required to conduct the round of the European and Polish Championships. Bearing in mind the safety of competitors, spectators, media representatives and people involved in the organization of this great international event, it was decided to postpone it to next year.

77th edition of Rally Poland in 2021 marked event's IOOth anniversary. Mikolajki-based rally was an opening round of FIA European Rally Championship. There were an impressive number of IO2 crews on the entry list, including stunning 44 in Rally2/R5 machinery, which are the fastest cars eligible in FIA ERC. Top European and Polish crews competed during three, hot summer days. Not a single raindrop fell, and rally cars blasted through fast Masurian stages leaving spectacular clouds of dirt and dust. Aleksey Lukyanuk, co-driven by Aleksey Arnautov, repeated his success from 2019 season and won Polish ERC counter for the second time in his career. Russian driver took the lead after SS 7 and kept Ist position until the finish. Andreas Mikkelsen and Ola Floene finished 2nd, I8,4 s behind winners. ORLEN Team driver Mikolaj Marczyk scored his maiden ERC podium finish in his only 9th outing in this series.

ORLEN 78th Rally Poland in 2022 was held as fourth round of European Rally Championship and third on gravel. For the first time in nine years Rally Poland has been won by Polish crew. Mikołaj Marczyk and Szymon Gospodarczyk (Skoda Fabia Rally2 evo) took their maiden FIA ERC win on home soil. Tom Kristensson and Andreas Johansson (Hyundai i20 R5) finished second overall, followed by Estonian crew Ken Torn Kauri Pannas (Ford Fiesta Rally2).

I.3. <u>ROUTE</u>

The total length of the rally is 919 kilometres, with 182 kilometres of 16 special stages. All ORLEN 79th Rally Poland speed tests are flowing and spectacular gravel stages. The participants of the oldest event in 2023 FIA ERC calendar will compete on stages known from previous editions of the rally, as well as on roads which have never been used before in Polish ERC counter.







The high-speed gravel battle in round three of 2023 FIA ERC will begin before opening ceremony, scheduled on Friday, 19th May, at 17:00 in Mikolajki. Before this, qualifying stage Baranowo (3,46 km) will be held. The results of qualifying runs are crucial in gravel events, as the fastest crews earn a right to choose starting position, which allows them to avoid sweeping loose gravel during leg one of the event. The first day of ORLEN 79th Rally Poland will be concluded with spectacular Mikolajki Arena test (2,5 km), where two crews compete simultaneously.

Saturday's itinerary comprises four special stages, with three of them run twice. Loop will begin with SS Swietajno (I8,58 km). The longest test in the rally will be followed by modified versions of SS Markowskie (I3,53 km) and Wieliczki (I7,35 km). Later, after service break nearby Golebiewski Hotel in Mikolajki, crews will tackle all three mentioned stages once again. Mikolajki Arena superspecial will conclude second day of ORLEN 79th Rally Poland.

Sunday in Polish ERC counter is packed with new challenges, with crews heading west of Mikolajki. The organisers prepared four stages, all run twice. The day will begin with two brand new stages: Barczewo (IO,73 km) and Biskupiec (I2,3 km). On their way back to Mikolajki competitors will cover SS Gmina Mragowo (9,4 km) and Mikolajki (6,68 km), which is a completely changed Mikolajki Max stage, known from previous editions of the event. Additional points will be awarded to five fastest crews on second pass of Gmina Mragowo test, held as Power Stage.

Finish ceremony is scheduled for 18:15 at Main Square in Mikolajki.

Reconnaissance cars and VIP vehicles are not allowed to enter the Service Park. Nearby Parking area will be available for the other registered vehicles (Recce/VIP). Trailers will not be allowed to park inside the Service Park.

5.3. SERVICE AREAS

The competitor is obliged to service only within the allocated service area in the Service Park. These regulations will be controlled by the Service Park Coordinator. Any infringement in this field will result in charging a double fee for additional service area.

5.3.3. Additional Area in the Service Park

5.4. MAXIMUM SPEED

Maximum speed inside the Service Park is limited by 30 km/h. Failure to comply with this limit shall result in a penalty applied by the Clerk of the Course as follows: 25 Euro per kilometer per hour over the speed limit.

5.5. CATERING WITHIN THE SERVICE PARK

Apart from the provision of a catering service for the drivers and service crew personnel of a team, any other form of catering or sale of food and beverages in the service park is prohibited. The only exception is where a written agreement has been entered into between a team and the Organisers. A fine of I OOO Euro will be applied in respect of any infringement of this regulation. The Organiser will provide a catering service within the Service Park for all team personnel and spectators.

5.6. SHOWS AND EXHIBITIONS IN SERVICE AREA

If any team or company would like to organise shows or exhibitions for their guests in service area, they must ask the Organiser for permission before Administrative Checks. All shows and exhibitions in service area without permission of the Organiser are strictly forbidden.

5.7. TIDINESS

All crews are obliged to use a liquid-proof tarp under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service Park have to be avoided. Each Competitor is liable for the damages to the Service Zone allocated to them. The crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage. After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a financial penalty 300 Euro applied by the Clerk of the Course.

7.I.2.2. Refuelling procedure

Solely for the purpose of assisting with the refuelling procedure of their car, two team members of each crew with the team passes may access the Refuelling Area. In order to access the RA, all personnel involved in refueling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava.

Engines must be switched off throughout the refuelling operation. It is required that the crew remain outside the car during refuelling.







The Organiser will provide to each competitor an Environnement Mat to protect the ground.

7.2. <u>TYRES</u>

7.2.1. Tyres specified for use during the rally

7.2.I.I. ERC

All tyres must be readily available commercially and must comply with Art. I3 and Appendix V of the 2023 Regional Rally Sporting Regulations.

7.2.I.I.I. Tyres for all ERCI, ERC3 and ERC4 priority competitors

Tyres must be supplied by an FIA-nominated tyre company. A list of nominated tyre manufacturers for the FIA European Rally Championship is published on <u>fia.com</u>.

7.2.1.1.2. Tyres for Junior ERC Championship

For the Junior ERC Championship, only Hankook tyres, sold at the rallies by the Junior ERC Championship tyre supplier, are eligible.

A driver may use only those tyres that have been registered for his car. Any tyre registered for a driver at a previous rally must be presented at the tyre supplier for checking and new registration before it can be used on a rally by the same driver.

All tires used by the crew during the rally must comply with art. I4 RSMP 2023 Regulations. During the rally, the tyres will be checked and marked in accordance with regulations. Tyres without homologation E must comply with regulations.

7.2.2. Tyres marking

Only tyres marked by the Organiser may be used. Any infringement to this rule will be reported to the Stewards.

7.2.2.1. Tyre marking locations

Tyre marking for the tyres that will be used during the Qualifying Stage will take place just before the start of Qualifying Stage.

Tyre marking for the tyres that will be used during the rally will take place at the exit of the Service Park located in Mikolajki.

7.2.2.2. Tyres will be checked for their conformity during the rally.

8. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

8.I. FROM THE EUROPEAN UNION

Poland is the European Union member. Competitors from the European Union do not need to make any special custom clearance for temporary import of cars and equipment for the purpose of participating in the ORLEN 79th Rally Poland.

8.2. FROM OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION

Non-EU competitors will need to show their ATA carnet (obtainable from the Chamber of Commerce of the country of origin) to customs authorities at their point of entry into the European Union.

9.I. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

A compulsory helicopters pilots' briefing will take place at O8:00 on Friday, I9 May 2023 at Rally HQ. Failing to attend the briefing will comply the exclusion from the registered helicopters list and the prohibition to over-fly restricted area.

I2. <u>RECONNAISSANCE</u>

I2.I. REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

Competitors are permitted a maximum of two passages over each special stage during Reconnaissance. All stages driven more than once in the rally will be considered as one stage for Reconnaissance purposes.

Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of the rally traffic, except in cases described in Recce Road Book (competitors may drive from the finish to the start of special stage using road which is a short part of the stage in the opposite direction of the rally traffic).







The speed limit on this part of stages during Reconnaissance is 40km/h.

Competitors may only enter a special stage through the start and exit through the finish.

The special stages will be open to normal traffic, therefore safety and rights of other road users must be respected. Competitors are reminded that vehicles may be travelling in the opposite direction.

Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

Competitors must fully respect the Polish Traffic Law regulations, including use seatbelts and speed limits:

- 50 km/h in the built-up area (if the signs does not show otherwise).
- 90 km/h outside the built-up area (if the signs does not show otherwise).

Maximum speed allowed during Reconnaissance is 70 km/h on special stages, unless a lower speed limit is indicated by traffic signs or by written instructions in the Road Book or Bulletin.

All Competitors must note that there will be police controls to prevent speeding or other road infringements. Any speeding offence whether recorded by police or officials on a special stage or on a road section, will result in a fine as shown in 2023 FIA-RRSR Art. 34.2. The fitting or carrying of radar detection equipment during Reconnaissance is forbidden.

12.2. REGISTRATION FORM

The Reconnaissance registration form including details of the car that will be used during Reconnaissance must be completed and submitted during the registration. This form is available at <u>www.rallypoland.pl</u> (Competitors section).

12.3. PARTICIPATION IN RECONNAISSANCE ONLY

Any driver holding an appropriate international license and not entered in the rally may apply to take part in the Reconnaissance. The registration form for this purpose must be sent by e-mail to <u>biuro@rallupoland.pl</u> before the closing date for entries. The final permission for taking part in Reconnaissance is left to the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. The fee for taking part only in Reconnaissance is 350 Euro. The regulations on Reconnaissance must be respected in their entirety.

I2.4. <u>RECONNAISSANCE SCHEDULE</u>

Reconnaissance will be held according to the schedule specified in Appendix I. The schedule of Reconnaissance must be fully respected by the crews. Reconnaissance outside the schedule as set by the Organiser is considered a very serious offence and will be reported to the Stewards who may apply a penalty.





IB. SHAKEDOWN, FREE PRACTICE AND QUALIFYING

IB.I. LOCATION

Free Practice, Qualifying Stage and Shakedown will be held in Baranowo, about IO,5 km from Service Park in Mikolajki. The stage is 3,46 km in length. Service Area and Refuelling Area for Free Practice and Qualifying Stage will be located in the main Service Park in Mikolajki: Hotel Gołębiewski parking -Mikołajki, ul. Mrągowska 34.

I3.2. <u>SCHEDULE</u>

13.3. <u>RULES</u>

Only competitors, who passed Administrative Checks and Scrutineering, can participate in Shakedown, Free Practice and Qualifying Stage. Competition numbers and advertising stickers must be affixed to their cars. It is compulsory to wear the safety equipment of driver and co-driver as for normal Special Stage.

Any passenger on board the car during Free Practice / Shakedown who is not entered for the rally must have signed a disclaimer provided by the Organiser. The form will be available in the Rally Office and at Free Practice / Shakedown start.

I4. START PROCEDURE

I4.I. PRE-START PARK

Before the Ceremonial Start, for all competitors participating in the rally, will be organized the Pre-start Park at the Mikolajki Main Square. Competitors must park their cars in pre-start area strongly according to the timetable which will be published on Friday, I9 May 2023 at I5:I5 on the Digital Notice Board. Any delay or early arrival will be penalized by IOO Euro. Cars may be driven by the crew or a representative of the team.

I4.2. START ORDER SELECTION

The selection of start positions, according to 2023 FIA-RRSR – VIa ERC Art. 37.8, will take place on Friday, I9 May 2023 at I6:30 at the Mikolajki Main Square. Only drivers are required to attend.

I4.3. CEREMONIAL START

The Ceremonial Start will take place at the Mikolajki Main Square on Friday, 19 May 2023 at 17:00. The starting order for the Ceremonial Start will be published on Friday, 19 May 2023 at 15:15 on the Digital Notice Board. The crews will start from the lowest to the highest starting numbers.







The crews must wear overalls and attend the Ceremonial Start with their competition cars. If any crew is unable to participate in the Ceremonial Start because of technical problems with their car, they will be permitted to start into the Leg I at TC O in its allocated start time on condition of notification to the Clerk of the Course and passing the obligatory Re-scrutineering Checks. The concerned crew must attend the Ceremonial Start wearing overalls at their due time anyway.

14.4. OFFICIAL START OF THE RALLY

The official start of the rally will take place at the TC O (Service - Out) on Friday, I9 May 2023 at I8:15. The starting order for Leg I (Section I) will be published on Friday, I9 May 2023 at I5:15 on the Digital Notice Board.

Parc Fermé before the TC O will not be organised.

Tyre Marking Zone and Refuelling Area will be located after TC O.

14.5. START INTERVALS

The start interval will be:

- during Qualifying Stage 2 minutes for all crews.
- during Ceremonial Start I minute for all crews.
- during the rally (except SSS I/8 Mikolajki Arena) 2 minutes for all crews.
- during SSS I/8 Mikolajki Arena 4 minutes for all crews (the cars will start in pairs).

I5. <u>FINISH PROCEDURE</u>

The Ceremonial Finish will take place at the Mikolajki Main Square on Sunday, 2I May 2023 at 18:15. First three crews of the rally will be awarded on the podium. Other prizes according to the Art. 14.2 of these Supplementary Regulations will be over-given on the finish ramp.

After the Ceremonial Finish, competitors are obliged to go straight to the final Parc Fermé and they must follow the route described in the Road Book. Cars are subject to Parc Fermé rules from the moment they reach the end of the competition element of the rally (TCI6D) until the Stewards have authorised the opening of the Parc Fermé.

IG. OFFICIAL PRE-RALLY TEST

IG.I. PARTICIPATION

The Organiser of ORLEN 79th Rally Poland will organise official pre-rally test for competitors, on Wednesday, I7 May 2023, 08:00-18:00 (I2:00-I3:00 technical break). The stage is 3.40 km in length and is representative for the rally. Further details will be send to all entered competitors or may be given after sending an inquiry to <u>biuro@rallypoland.pl</u>.







16.2. <u>RULES</u>

Official pre-rally test will be run as if it were a stage run during the rally with full technical and medical support and professional time measurement.

Any passenger on board (driver and co-driver) must have an approval from the Organiser and must declare and sign that goes on his own risk (not of a responsibility of the Organiser) – the form will be available at the start.

Only first driver entered to the rally can drive the car during pre-rally test.

During the test, any person on board must wear a homologated crash helmet, all required safety clothing and equipment in compliance with Appendix L Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment and have seat belt correctly fastened.

Please read carefully the rules below to ensure all the requested information is included in the application and it is forwarded to the correct organization i.e. WRC Promoter or ORLEN 79th Rally Poland Accreditation Office.

The accreditation is only provided to media representatives who intend to report on ORLEN 79th Rally Poland and they are widely available to the public. Media accreditation is restricted to professional journalists, photographers, radio and TV reporters and camera operators.







The Media Pass is considered a working tool and it cannot be used for public relations, promotions or entertainment purposes. No advertising, public relation agency or similar company or organization will be accredited as media. Nor will the Rally issue any media accreditation to representatives (press officers or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, teams, drivers etc.

17.3. PRINT MEDIA, RADIO, WEBSITES, MEDIA AGENCIES

Representatives and photographers of print media, radio, websites (excluding filming) or media agencies (national and international) apply for accreditation using an online accreditation form.

Internet accreditation is intended for professional stand-alone internet editorial / news websites only.

No more than two representatives of any media outlet will be accredited including only one photographer.

Freelance photographers and journalists may be accredited if giving the evidence of relevant articles and photographs published. Examples of articles and photographs can be sent as scanned files by email to <u>media@rallypoland.pl</u>.

Media requests must be sent no later than on Monday, I May 2023. Applications which are late, incomplete or illegible will not be considered.

17.4. TELEVISION & FILMING ACCREDITATION PROCEDURES

International and national TV wishing to cover the Rally must apply via e-mail to <u>accreditation@fiaerc.com</u>. This also applies to all media wanting to record any footage of the Rally.

Those accredited as television, or with authorization to film, must be aware that no action footage recording is allowed. Television and other media accredited to film will only be allowed to record images in the Service Park.
